Port State Control and Commercial Yachts

The Cayman Islands Shipping Registry would like to remind all our commercially registered yachts that they are eligible for a Port State Control (PSC) Inspection at any time.

Due to recent detentions in our fleet, most notably in Italy, we would like to introduce the attached PSC Checklist which has been developed as a simple aide memoire for pre-arrival checks.

For our commercial yachts under 500GT, we would like to offer a free remote video call upon request to run through this checklist and assist with compliance. Please contact technical@cishipping.com to arrange your video call.

Both Paris & Tokyo MOUs are currently running a Concentrated Inspection Campaign on STCW to raise awareness on the specific requirements of the STCW Convention and Code. View the Paris MOU Press release here.

It is of paramount importance that all mandatory certification/records/documentation are always valid and available onboard. Typical deficiencies include expired certificates, no Flag State endorsements, charts missing/uncorrected for intended voyage, Garbage Management Plan missing, non functioning BNWAS, etc.
